ORDER No. R4-2009-0028

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- 1. On April 3, 2003, this Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No. R4-2003 for Naval Base Ventura County, Port Hueneme Facility to demonstrate and evaluate an in-well device to measure groundwater flux using the release of alcohol.
- 2. On August 13, 2008, this Regional Board received a letter from the Department of the Navy in which it was indicated that all activities related to the demonstration and evaluation of the in-well groundwater flux measurement device at Naval Base Ventura County Port Hueneme facility were completed in 2004, and that the WDR should be rescinded.
- 3. Board finds that the requirements of Order No. R4-2003-0056 are no longer applicable and shall be rescinded.
- 4. The rescission of WDRs is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

This Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of Order No. R4-2003-0056 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations. This Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the Order.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board is authorized, and she is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefore, or may request same.
