**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND BY SMALL DOMESTIC WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS – FIRE STATION NO. 88, 23720 WEST MALIBU ROAD, MALIBU, CA (FILE NO. 02-171, ORDER NO. 97-010-DWQ, CI NO. 8621, SERIES NO. 013, GEOTRACKER GLOBAL ID-100001179)**

Dear Mr. Jimenez:

Our letter dated August 19, 2003, informed your department that Fire Station No. 88 (Facility) located at 23720 West Malibu Road, Malibu is regulated under Order No. 97-010-DWQ, which specifies the Waste Discharge Requirements for the onsite wastewater treatment system (OWTS) installed at the Facility.

On July 19, 2018, we received your termination request letter stating that the wastewater generated from the Facility had been connected to a sewer line and delivered to the Malibu Civic Center Wastewater Treatment Facility since May 31, 2018. Since no more wastewater discharge to the OWTS of the Facility is anticipated, the coverage under Order No. 97-010-DWQ, File No. 02-171, and CI-8621 is no longer needed, and therefore is hereby terminated.
