TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY—OXNARD GAS LINES RELOCATION PROJECT, RICE AVENUE AND GONZALES ROAD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-8647)

In our letter dated January 10, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0109, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on July 1, 2004, which also serves as your NPDES permit.


We have received and reviewed your June 11, 2009, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit because you have completed the subject project. In addition, you have not discharged any hydrostatic test water from the subject project site since the General Permit was issued.

On June 24, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of hydrostatic test water from the subject site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of hydrostatic test water from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109, General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001, for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any hydrostatic test water to surface water become necessary at the site, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
