GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE PERMIT ENROLLMENT UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY (STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD WATER QUALITY ORDER NO. 2003-0003-DWQ: SERIES 001) FOR PROPOSED DISCHARGE OF DRILLING MUD, CUTTINGS, AND DEVELOPMENT WATER AT PROPOSED FULLER FALLS MUTUAL WATER COMPANY IRRIGATION WELL NO. 3, 9067 VISTA ANACAPA DRIVE, MOORPARK CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 03-139, CI-8662)

We have completed our review of your application, the Discharge Monitoring Program (DMP) dated October 29, 2003, and the Notice of Intent for enrollment under the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. 2003 - 0003 - DWQ General Waste Discharge Requirements. Your application proposes the discharge of well development water and drilling mud and cuttings.

Fuller Falls Mutual Water Company (Fuller) proposes to construct Irrigation Well No. 3 on the property owned by Fremont HGS, LLC (Fremont). Fuller proposes to discharge development water from Irrigation Well No. 3 to a local orchard for irrigation and to discharge the drilling mud and cuttings in place in a sump pit at a location near the well head. The well construction project is located at Latitude: N34° 18' 08", Longitude: W118° 56' 27".

Regional Board staff have reviewed the information provided and have determined that the proposed discharge meets the conditions specified in State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ, "*Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality*", adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board on April 30, 2003.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, consisting of State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ (Series No. 001). Please note that the discharge limits in Attachment A (DWR Basin No. 4-8: Las Posas Valley - South Las Posas Area - NW of Grimes Canyon Road) are applicable to your well development discharge.

You are required to implement the DMP on the effective date of this enrollment (November 12, 2003). All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8662", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. When the well development and sump disposal activities are completed, please submit a completed Notice of Termination (NOT) form (included in Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ). If Fuller fails to submit the NOT, Fuller would be subject to ongoing annual fees for the project.
