**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL COMMERCIAL SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS – MINT CANYON MOBILE MANOR, 16408 SIERRA HIGHWAY, CANYON COUNTRY, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 02-067, CI-8675)**

Dear Ms. Smith:

We received a letter dated January 2, 2006, from Mr. George Bryson, Mint Canyon Mobile Manor manager, requesting that we terminate your enrollment under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (Order No. 01-031), for discharge of domestic wastewater from the mobile home park (Park) commonly known as Mint Canyon Mobile Manor. The Park is located in the Eastern Santa Clara/Santa Clara-Mint Canyon Groundwater basin at longitude: 118°25'12", and latitude: 34°27'00". In the letter, Mr. Bryson indicated that the Park collection system was connected to the Los Angeles County Sanitation District collection system on December 23, 2005. Regional Board staff conducted a field inspection on December 30, 2005 and verified that no discharges were occurring and the septic system was decommissioned.

Since there is no discharge of domestic wastewater at the site, coverage under Board Order No. 01-031 for the facility is hereby terminated, effective December 23, 2005.
