TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT SOCO WEST, INC., 3270 EAST WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, VERNON, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2002-0030, SERIES NO. 041, CI NO. 8676, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100000077)

Dear Mr. Mehta:

In our letter dated December 16, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No.R4-2002-0030 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated February 29, 2012, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased molasses injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR. Therefore, the coverage for the subject facility, under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit. However, a new WDR permit will be required for the additional pilot testing proposed in the approved Perched Groundwater Treatment Pilot Test Work Plan dated December 22, 2011.
