

TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY FROM CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING AT SOUTH BRANCH ARROYO CONEJO DEBRIS BASIN MODIFICATION PROJECT, THOUSAND OAK, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 03-188, CI-8691)

Dear Mr. Pratt:

We have received a letter dated January 26, 2005, from your Project Manager, Design & Construction Division, Mr. Masood Jilani, requesting that we terminate your enrollment under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (Order No. 2003-003-DWQ), for discharge of groundwater produced during the dewatering activity at the South Branch Arroyo Conejo Debris Basin Modification project located adjacent to Reino Road, between Lynn Road and Maurice Drive, in the southwestern quadrant of City of Thousand Oaks, which is known as the Newbury Park area, California. In the letter, Mr. Jilani indicated that the construction was completed on June 25, 2004.

Since there is no discharge of water at the site, coverage under Board Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ for the facility is hereby terminated, effective January 26, 2005.
