Dear Mr. Strawn:

In our letter dated March 5, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0030, (Series No. 046), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated September 14, 2005, you notified the Regional Board that the in-situ remediation of total petroleum hydrocarbons performed for the site is complete and that you requested termination of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. Since you have completed the in-situ remediation and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030, (Series No. 046), for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
