TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ATLANTIC RICHFIELD CO.—FORMER BP CHEMICAL SITE, 1600 WEST 135<sup>th</sup> STREET, GARDENA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI-8770)

In our letter dated July 6, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0107, Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-sites to Surface Waters in the Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on May 23, 2002, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In the letter dated June 8, 2007, your consultant, Parsons, informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed in June 2007. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, your consultant requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES Permit. On August 9, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site. Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0107 for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
