TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS - CITY OF OXNARD, WELL Nos. 20, 22, 23, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 (NPDES No. CAG994005, CI-8802)

Dear Mr. Rydberg:

The subject discharges are regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005 (hereafter Order No. R4-2003-0108), adopted by the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board on August 7, 2003.

On November 18, 2014 the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted the Statewide National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Drinking Water Systems Discharges to Waters of the United States, Order No. 2014-0194-DWQ, General Order No. CAG140001 (hereafter the Order). The Order provides regulatory coverage for short-term or seasonal planned and emergency (unplanned) discharges resulting from a water purveyor's essential operations and maintenance activities undertaken to comply with the federal Safe Drinking Water Act, the California Health and Safety Code, and the State Water Board's Division of Drinking Water permitting requirements for providing reliable delivery of safe drinking water. The Order became effective on February 26, 2015.

On October 15, 2015, the City of Oxnard, Water Resources Division submitted a completed application package to State Water Board for coverage under the Order. On May 26, 2016, the State Water Board issued a Notice of Applicability to City of Oxnard for coverage under the Order.

Therefore, coverages for the City of Oxnard, Water Resources Division (WDID 4A567600028) under Order R4-2003-0108 are no longer necessary and are hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
