TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ARCHSTNONE-SMITH OPERATING TRUST– ARCHSTONE SANTA MONICA APARTMENT BUILDING PROJECT, 2000 MAIN STREET, SANTA MONICA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8869)

In our letter dated March 2, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your June 23, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that no groundwater was discharged during the construction activities at the above-referenced project site.

On June 24, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any groundwater to storm drain become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and appropriate obtain waste discharge requirements.
