**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
– FORMER STA-LUBE FACILITY, 3039 ANA STREET, REANCHO DOMINGUEZ,
CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2002-0030, SERIES NO. 060, CI-8886, SCP FILE NO. 0263)**

In our letter dated April 15, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0030, Series No. 060, which also serves as your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

By letter dated December 24, 2008, you notified the Regional Board that In-situ Chemical Oxidation for remediation of the site is complete and that you request rescission of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in the *WDR Summary Report*, dated October 12, 2007, and *Site Closure Evaluation and Piezometers MW-13B and MW14B Data Evaluation Report*, dated January 18, 2008. The Regional Board granted the site closure on June 3, 2008. Since the In-situ Chemical Oxidation has been completed and the WDR is no longer needed, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030, Series No. 060 for the subject facility is hereby terminated.
