TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—MHTA HOUSING CORPORATION– NORTHWEST GATEWAY APARTMENT PROJECT, 1304 W. 2nd STREET, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8890)

In our letter dated May 4, 2005, we informed Meta Housing Corporation that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your March 21, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that no groundwater was encountered during the construction activities at the above-referenced project site.

On March 25, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any groundwater to storm drain become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and appropriate obtain waste discharge requirements.
