

TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—GOLDEN STATE WATER COMPANY, HAWAIIAN WELL, 20702 HAWAIIAN AVENUE, CITY OF LAKEWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI-8898))

In our letter dated June 21, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0058, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Nonprocess Wastewater to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on April 1, 2004., which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your March 19, 2010, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have installed a recycling device within the treatment facility at the site and ceased wastewater discharge.

On April 7, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2004-0058, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994003, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).
