TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – FORMER 76 STATION NO. 5621, 948 SOUTH AZUSA AVENUE, CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 147, CI-8917, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100001397)

Dear Mr. Bishop,

On January 20, 2011, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated April 17, 2013, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased injection of ozone at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since Chevron Environmental Management Company has no plan to inject ozone in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
