**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR WASTE DISCHARGES TO LAND BY SMALL DOMESTIC WASTEWATER SYSTEMS – TONY'S COLLISION SERVICES, INC., 497 LAMBERT ROAD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA, (FILE NO. 05-115, CI-8930)**

On July 12, 2010, Regional Board staff was informed by Mr. Bill Lykins, Staff Services Specialist with Ventura County's Water and Sanitation Department, that your facility located at 497 Lambert Street was connected to the County's municipal sewer collection system on June 4, 2010.

Your septic tank and disposal leachfield must be properly abandoned in accordance with the California Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC).

Effective June 4, 2010, your facility ceased to discharge domestic wastewater. Coverage under general waste discharge requirements of the State Water Resources Control Board, Order No. 97-10-DWQ, "General Waste Discharges to Land by Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems", for this facility is hereby terminated.

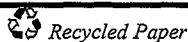
