REVISED GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CASTAIC LAKE WATER AGENCY - EARL SCHMIDT FILTRATION PLANT AND RIO VISTA TREATMENT PLANT, HYDROSTATIC TEST & OVERFLOW DISCHARGES, 32700 N. LAKE HUGHES ROAD, CASTAIC & 27234 BOUQUET CANYON ROAD, SANTA CLARITA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-8958)

In our letter dated September 23, 2005, we authorized the discharge of hydrostatic test water and overflows from the subject facilities under General Permit NPDES No. CAG674001, Order No. R4-2004-0109; *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties (General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001)*, adopted by this Board on July 1, 2004.

We have received and reviewed your October 5, 2005, submittal requesting this Board to cover 18 additional Outfalls under the above referenced general permit. We have no objection to including the additional Outfalls, which all eventually drain to the Santa Clara River.

The discharge limitations in Section E Order No. R4-2004-0109 are applicable to your discharge. Discharges from the subject facilities drain to the Santa Clara River between Bouquet Canyon Bridge and West Pier Highway 99. Therefore, the discharge limitations in Attachment B.3.c. are also applicable to your discharge. Prior to starting discharge, a representative sample of the effluent must be obtained and analyzed to determine compliance with the discharge limitations.

Enclosed are the revised Fact Sheet and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MR&P) No. CI-8958. The MR&P requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under Order No. R4-2004-0109. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8958 and NPDES No. CAG674001", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
