GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 030, MRP NO. CI-8984), HRC INJECTION – FORMER PNEUMO ABEX AEROSPACE FACILITY, 3151 WEST 5TH STREET, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 02-150, SLIC NO. 253B, SITE ID. NO. 2043000)

Dear Mr. Larson:

Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) staff have completed our review of your application for coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) for the injection of hydrogen releasing compound (HRC) into soil and groundwater for full-scale remediation. We have determined that the proposed discharge meets the conditions specified in Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, "Revised General Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Remediation at Petroleum Hydrocarbon Fuel and/or Volatile Organic Compound Impacted Sites," adopted by this Regional Board on May 5, 2005. Refer to the attached Fact Sheet.

You may begin to inject a maximum of 100,000 pounds of HRC at the approximate locations and depths indicated in the October 31, 2005 Remedial Action Plan, which was approved by the Regional Board in a letter dated November 20, 2005.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, consisting of Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030 (Series 030) and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8984. Please note that the discharge limits in Attachment A [DWR Basin No. 4-4 (Oxnard Plain – Unconfined and Perched Aquifers)] of this Order No. R4-2005-0030 are applicable to your discharge.

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of this enrollment (December 8, 2005) under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030. All monitoring reports shall be sent to the Regional Board, <u>ATTN: Information Technology Unit.</u>

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8984", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
