TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—KB HOME, NORTH LOS ANGELES DIVISION– SEGMENT D OF TRACT NO. 5353 TOWNHOMES PROJECT, RIVER STREET, FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9001)

In our letter dated December 13, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your February 29, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that no groundwater was encountered during the construction activities at the above-referenced project site.

On June 26, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Santa Clara River. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of any groundwater to storm drain become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
