

TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—NORTHSHORE AT MANDALAY BAY EAST RESIDENTIAL HOMES CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, HARBOR BLVD. & W. 5TH ST., VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9050)

Dear Mr. Teller:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have reviewed your November 14, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the building construction project at the above-referenced site and that no groundwater was discharged from the subject site to the Mandalay Canal.

On April 22, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Mandalay Canal. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
