**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, LOW FLOW DIVERSION PROJECT 5243, WASHINGTON BOULEVARD AND THATCHER AVENUE, MARINA DEL REY (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI—9065)**

In our letter dated April 21, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On February 12, 2007, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed in December 2006. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On February 23, 2007, our staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the project to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any questions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576-6794.
