TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF FILLMORE-SESPE CREEK LEVEE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, SESPE CREEK NEAR HIGHWAY 126 BRIDGE, FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9070)

In our letter dated September 19, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In your letter dated February 5, 2008, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project has been completed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES permit. On February 25, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters.

Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
