## TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—EXXONMOBIL OIL CORPORATION, SOUTHWEST TERMINAL AREA 1, 799 SOUTH SEASIDE AVENUE, TERMINAL ISLAND, CALIFORNIA (CAG994004, CI—9074)

Dear Mr. Brett:

In our letter dated January 8, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In your letter dated July 21, 2008, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed in March 2007. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On March 18, 2009, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any guestions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576–6794.
