TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS— CONOCOPHILLIPS PIPELINE COMPANY, LOS ANGELES TERMINAL 12-INCH PIPELINE RELOCATION PROJECT, 20805 NORMANDIE AVENUE, TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-9097)


In our letter dated June 23, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0109, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on July 1, 2004, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your November 14, 2006, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that the above-referenced project has been completed.

On March 6, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2004-0109, General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
