TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM SITE 24 (FORMER UST SITES 23 AND 55), NAVAL BASE VENTURA COUNTY, POINT MUGU, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 047, CI NO. 9099, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100000779)

Dear Mr. Granade:

In our letter dated July 14, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No.R4-2005-0030 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

The WDR allowed the injection of lactate and soy oil at Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 24 during the implementation of the pilot test. Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) authority, the Installation Commanding Officer signed a Record of Decision on August 2008, established enhanced bioremediation as the remedy for IRP Site 24.

In the letter dated March 15, 2012, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Order No. R4-2005-0030 because CERCLA Section 121(e) (1) provides that no permits shall be required to implement on-site remedies where the remedies are selected and carried out in accordance with Section 121. Therefore, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Order No. R4-2005-0030, for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
