TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—HAYDEN ENVIRONMENTAL INC., CAL-U-RENT, 661 E. THOUSAND OAKS BLVD., THOUSAND OAKS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI–9211)

Dear Mr. Hayden:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0021, Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.

We have reviewed your December 5, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have stopped the cleanup project at the above-referenced site and that the groundwater discharge from the subject site to the Calleguas Creek has been ceased.

On April 22, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Calleguas Creek. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0021, General NPDES Permit No. CAG834001, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
