TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF ARCADIA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS—COLORADO WELL AQUIFER TESTING, DEVELOPMENT, AND START-UP PROJECT, 500 WEST COLORADO STREET, ARCADIA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI—9216)

Dear Mr. Herman:

In our letter dated December 13, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

On August 17, 2011, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced well development project was completed on August 11, 2011. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On April 23, 2012, staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
