**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE
REQUIREMENTS – 76 SERVICE STATION NO. 3319, 4502 EAST ROSECRANS AVENUE,
COMPTON, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 026, CI-9297)**

Dear Mr. Harris:

In our letter dated October 25, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 026), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 9, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased the ozone injection and requested termination of the WDR. You switched to injection of oxygen amended air on June 23, 2009, which does not require WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. Since you ceased the ozone injection and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 026), for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
