Dear Mr. Hermann:

On September 28, 2007 this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated November 9, 2012, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased re-injection of treated groundwater and injection of Fenton's reagent at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since HAH Marine Properties has no plan to re-inject treated groundwater and inject Fenton's reagent in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
