TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT FORMER ROBERT E. MACK PLUMBING, 3031 WEST FIFTH STREET, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 034, CI-9318, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100001657)

Dear Mr. Hermann:

On September 28, 2007 this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated November 9, 2012, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased reinjection of treated groundwater and injection of Fenton's reagent at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since HAH Marine Properties has no plan to re-inject treated groundwater and inject Fenton's reagent in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
