TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—VENICE/MARINA DEL REY LOW FLOW DIVERSION CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, 4445 ADMIRALTY WAY, VENICE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9337)

Dear Mr. Farber:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed your March 24, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the construction project at the above-referenced site and that no groundwater was discharged from the subject site to the Pacific Ocean.

On August 18, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Pacific Ocean. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.

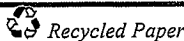
