TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—VOPAK TERMINAL LOS ANGELES INC., TANK 105, 2200 EAST PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, WILMINGTON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-9345)

Dear Ms. Oblea:

In our letter dated November 28, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0109, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On April 23, 2009, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On May 21, 2009, our staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

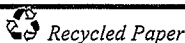
Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
