TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON—McGRATH PEAKER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, 251 N. HARBOR BOULEVARD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9351)


The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed your August 10, 2012, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the project and the permit is no longer needed. On September 19, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of hydrostatic test water from the site coverage under Board Order R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001, CI-9351 for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
