**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – NAVAL FACILITIES ENGINEERING SERVICE CENTER, SEAWATER DESALINATION TEST FACILITY, PORT HUENEME, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0064564, CI NO. 9397)**

Our letter dated April 22, 2008, transmitted a tentative order for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

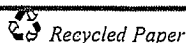
Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 5, 2008, reviewed the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs), considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2008-0030 (copy attached) relative to this waste discharge. Order No. R4-2008-0030 serves as your permit under the NPDES program and expires on May 10, 2013. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

You are required to implement the *Monitoring and Reporting Program* (MRP) on the effective date of Order No. R4-2008-0030. Your first monitoring report for the July 2008, reporting period is due by November 1, 2008. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge under Order No. R4-2008-0030 to the Regional Board, please include a reference to *Compliance File No. CI 9397 and NPDES No. CA0064564*, which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Please submit each type of report as a separate document.



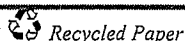
