TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR CADILLACS ONLY, 1015 MISSION ROCK ROAD, SANTA PAULA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 08-040, ORDER NO. 01-031, SERIES NO. 102, CI-9398, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100000989)

Dear Mr. Pierce:

On May 15, 2008, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 01-031, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

On October 2, 2014, you requested termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. 01-031 because the subject property was foreclosed in December, 2010 and Zion Bank took possession of the Property as of January, 2011. The subject property is still vacant and no discharge had occurred. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. 01-031, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
