

TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT FORMER 76 STATION NO. 5572, 341 WEST GONZALEZ ROAD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 064, CI-9421)

Dear Mr. Staab:

In our letter dated July 8, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated October 14, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased ozone injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since ConocoPhillips has no plans to inject ozone into the groundwater in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
