EXPIRATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – FORMER C-1 FACILITY, BUILDING 10 AREA, 3855 NORTH LAKEWOOD BOULEVARD, LONG BEACH, CANIFORNIA (FILE NO. 95-034, ORDER NO. R4-2008-0033, CI NO. 9423, GLOBAL ID WDR100000317)

Dear Mr. Scott:

On June 5, 2008, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2008-0033 (Order), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).

In a letter dated April 30, 2013 from Mr. Adam Boettner on behalf of The Boeing Company, you notified the Regional Board that no additional WDR-permitted enhanced in situ bioremediation (EISB) is planned at the subject area, and requested termination of the WDR immediately. In addition, according to the Regional Board's records, no Report of Waste Discharge has been filed since issuance of the Order on Jun 5, 2008.

Please note that the Order expired on June 5, 2013 (See Order, p. 9). Therefore, there is no need to terminate an Order that has already expired.
