Dear Mr. Porter:

On August 14, 2008, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated October 9, 2012, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under letter Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the Los Angeles City Fire Department as lead agency, in the letter dated August 31, 2012, determined that no further action was required for soil remediation at the site. Therefore, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
