**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT— CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER COMPANY— SAN MARINO—NEW PATTON WELL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, 1100 ARDEN ROAD, PASADENA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9515)**

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.


We have reviewed your September 10, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have stopped the groundwater discharge to the storm drain.

On July 19, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.

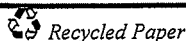
