TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT FORMER CHEVRON STATION 9-3493, 1900 EAST LOS ANGELES AVENUE, SIMI VALLEY, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 105, CI-9516)

Dear Ms. Fredrichs:

In our letter dated June 23, 2009, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No.R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 20, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased hydrogen peroxide injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since Chevron Environmental Management Company has no plan to inject hydrogen peroxide into the groundwater in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Board Order No.R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
