
Dear Mr. Schanen:

On August 5, 2011, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the application of ozone as a pilot test for in-situ groundwater remediation is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated May 8, 2015, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the ozone injection was completed. The last injection of ozone occurred in April 2014 and no additional injection of ozone is planned. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
