TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF OXNARD, VICTORIA AVENUE SEWER LINE PROJECT, ALONG VICTORIA AVENUE, BETWEEN CHANNEL ISLANDS BOULEVARD AND HEMLOCK AVENUE, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI—9604)

Dear Mr. Barderrama:

In our letter dated May 17, 2010, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On December 19, 2011, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed on July 12, 2011. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On May 3, 2012, staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
