TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT SANTA CLARA RIVER WEIR FIELD DOWNSTREAM OF HIGHWAY 101, VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 09-187, ORDER NO. 93-010, SERIES NO. 042, CI-9609, GLOBAL ID WDR 100000078)

Dear Mr. Norman:

On June 17, 2010, Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated April 23, 2012, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010 because construction activities requiring the discharge of construction dewatering groundwater to land ended on March 23, 2012. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
