TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR JEPSON WASH DEBRIS BASIN SPILLWAY RETROFIT, VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 11-041, ORDER NO. 93-010, SERIES NO. 043, CI-9689, GLOBAL ID WDR 100000646)

Dear Mr. Norman:

On May 31, 2011, Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated February 6, 2012, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010 because no discharge of groundwater had occurred during construction and no groundwater will be discharged after construction is completed. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
