TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—
CALLEGUAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, SALINITY MANAGEMENT PIPELINE, PHASE 2A, OLD LEWIS/S. LEWIS RD – CAMARILLO RD TO CAWELTI RD, CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-9720)

Dear Mr. Beamer:

In our letter dated June 20, 2011, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2009-0068, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties.

On April 26, 2013, Calleguas Municipal Water District (CMWD) informed the Regional Board that CMWD has completed all discharges under the subject NPDES permit for the Salinity Management Pipeline Phase 2A project. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, CMWD requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On June 4, 2013, Regional Board staff inspected the subject project and verified that there is no discharge of hydrostatic test water to surface water. Therefore, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2009-0068 for the subject project is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of hydrostatic test water to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
