Dear Mr. Puig:

On January 6, 2012, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated January 8, 2013, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the Ventura County Environmental Health Division, in August 29, 2012 letter, has determined that the subject site is eligible for low-risk regulatory case closure. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 for the subject site is no longer needed and hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
