TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER REVISED GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AT PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON FUEL, VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUND AND/OR HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM IMPACTED SITES — BRAGG CRANE FACILITY, 6251 NORTH PARAMOUNT BOULEVARD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 11-165, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 182, CI-9773, GLOBAL ID. WDR100001851)

Dear Mr. Kupfer:

On January 20, 2012, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2007-0019. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Groundwater Remediation Work Plan* for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds at the Bragg Crane facility.

On January 6, 2020, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of activated persulfate was never implemented and is not planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2009-0017 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
