TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIED DISCHARGES TO GROUNDWATER – SHERWOOD DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, CARLISLE CANYON TRACT 4192-5 AND 6, WESTLAKE VILLAGE, VENTURA COUNTY, CA (ORDER NO. 93-010, FILE NO. 13-043, SERIES NO. 045, CI NO. 9931, GLOBAL ID WDR100011244)

In our letter dated May 6, 2013, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 93-010, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated April 17, 2014, Mr. Charles Cohn, your representative, notified the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) that the discharges of groundwater stemming from the dewatering activities due to the utility line installation at the project site for which the permit was issued had been completed and that you request termination of the WDR.

Since the discharge of groundwater has been ceased, and the WDR is no longer needed, the coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, Series No. 045 for the subject facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes under the term of the permit.
