TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AT PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON FUEL, VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPUND AND/OR HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM IMPACTED SITES – FORMER CHEMOIL REFINERY, 2020 WALNUT AVENUE, SIGNAL HILL, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 13-011, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 219, CI NO. 9933, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100009997)

Dear Ms. Vila:

On April 24, 2013, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2007-0019. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Interim Remedial Action Plan* to remediate soil and groundwater contaminated with petroleum hydrocarbons at the Former Chemoil Refinery.

On April 24, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of nutrients was completed in October 2017 and no additional injection activities are planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2007-0019 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
