## TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BOEING COMPANY, FORMER HUGHES AIRCRAFT COMPANY, ELECTRON DYNAMICS DIVISION SITE, 3100 WEST LOMITA BOULEVARD, TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 12-086, CI-9978, ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 048, GLOBAL ID WDR100007517)

Dear Ms. Courtney:

On October 23, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the re-injection of groundwater treated by liquid-phase granular activated carbon (GAC) to reduce the concentration of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated September 30, 2016, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 because no injection of treated groundwater has occurred and no future injection of treated groundwater is planned due to Boeing's change of treatment and disposal plans. As a result, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
